REHEARSALS & SHOW DATES

Rehearsals will commence on Monday 2nd July and will run throughout July and August. We will rehearse three to four times per week. Not every group will be required each day and you may only be called for a portion of the day. Rehearsals in September and October will be confined to Sundays only. Our aim is to have the show fully blocked and staged by the end of August. Sunday rehearsals will be to polish and finesse. Given the lengthy rehearsal process we can accommodate anyone going on holidays. A maximum of 2 weeks is permitted. <u>All casts must be</u> <u>available for full day rehearsals from Sunday 28th October - Wednesday 31st</u> <u>October (mid term break).</u> If you cannot be present for all these dates please do not audition.

If you tick "dancer/ ensemble" as a role you would accept, then you will be cast in the show (in either an ensemble, principal, featured or supporting role). Students interested in performance are strongly encouraged to accept any role, as parts of all sizes are an opportunity to learn and grow as a performer.

CASTING POLICY

Participating in a Montfort College production is a positive and enriching experience, and an important part of many students' time at Montforts. The audition process is designed to be transparent, fair and enjoyable for students. At the same time, auditions can be stressful and the outcomes occasionally disappointing. Regardless of the outcome, auditions are a learning opportunity. Students who audition for multiple productions in their time at Montforts will gain valuable experience, skills and confidence, which translate to future theatrical endeavours and other artistic pursuits. How roles are cast can be a difficult process to understand, especially from the outside. Assembling a cast is like assembling a jigsaw puzzle: directors must consider the parts available in the show, the unique artistic vision of the production, individual audition performance of actors in the casting pool as well as the overall cohesiveness of casting.

In auditions, students are evaluated on their acting ability, attitude and demeanour. For the musical, students are also evaluated on singing and dancing ability. Directors will be looking to see whether an individual student has the skills necessary to perform specific roles and considering how all students fit into a cohesive vision for the show. Preference in casting is not given based on seniority or to students who have participated in past Montfort productions. While there is never any guarantee for a student, individuals who consistently demonstrate a positive attitude and work ethic in auditions and rehearsals are most likely to be in good standing at future auditions.

On the audition form, students are asked to indicate whether they would accept principal, supporting or dance / ensemble roles. Students interested in performance are strongly encouraged to accept any role, as parts of all sizes are an opportunity to learn and grow as a performer.

SHOW FEE

There is a \notin 50 show fee for all those who are successfully cast to cover all rehearsals.
